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# Certificate notes

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## 1. Correct use of the published ratings

**TCC** The time correction coefficient to be used, with the following exceptions:

**No spinnaker fleet** To be used when competing in a class which does not permit the use of a spinnaker.

**Mixed fleet** To be used when rated without a spinnaker **or** when permitted to elect not to use a spinnaker **and** when competing in a class which permits the use of a spinnaker.

## 2. Data quality

The fairest ratings will result from accurate measurement; ratings calculated using a significant amount of estimated and published data are far more likely to be out of line with expectations than those using measured and sister ship data. Owners must notify the rating office of any changes or errors in the rating data.

## 3. Applicability

This certificate is issued for the sole purpose of correcting elapsed times recorded in yacht races. It is not to be used for any other purpose.
